News Release

The police department responded to 565 incidents in the week of July 20, 2014 through July 26, 2014. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

Vehicle Recovery, 07/21/14, 7700 15 Pl SE

A vehicle reported stolen from the City of Marysville was found abandoned.

CPS Referral, 07/21/14, 700 SR 9 NE

A witness reported observing a 22 year old female slap a small child, slamming the child's head onto a car. Officers located the female with two children. After speaking with the female and finding no obvious injuries to the child, it was determined that a report would be forwarded to CPS for follow up.

Trespass, 07/21/14, 2200 123 Av NE

Two fourteen year old males were found trying to open doors at a school after setting off the alarm. The parents of the teens were contacted and an informational report was taken.

Counterfeit, 07/22/14, 300 91 Av NE

A customer was found attempting to make a purchase with a counterfeit bill.

While responding to a complaint of suspicious behavior by two door-to-door salesmen, officers were able to locate the subjects, along with others who were also selling in the area. Three males reported being assaulted as they were walking by unknown subjects who jumped out at them from a lifted white pickup. Case under investigation.
