News Release

The police department responded to 502 incidents in the week of November 09, 2014 through November 15, 2014. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

Assault 4 Domestic Violence (DV), 11/10/14, 1600 blk. of 88th Dr. NE

A 47-year old male was arrested for Assault 4 DV. Officers were dispatched to a report of a husband being physical with his 47-year old wife. While officers were enroute, the male fled the scene. Upon investigation, it was found that the male struck the female several times and broke several household items. The male returned home a short while later and was taken into custody. He was booked into Marysville Jail.

Possession of Dangerous Weapon/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/Trespass, 11/10/14, 1800 blk. of 90th DR SE

A 47-year old male was arrested for Possession of a Dangerous Weapon, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Trespassing. Officers responded to a trespass call in which the recently evicted male was unlawfully back at the residence. The consented search incident to arrest revealed drug paraphernalia and a dangerous weapon. The male was booked into the Marysville Jail.

Malicious Mischief, 11/11/14, 10500 blk. of 1st Place NE

A 50-year old male was arrested for Malicious Mischief. During an argument with his 44-year old wife, the male threw pictures against a wall, causing them to shatter. This case has been forwarded to the City Prosecutor.

Possession of Burglary Tools/Trespass, 11/12/14, 8700 blk. of 11 St NE

An 18-year old male was arrested for Possession of Burglary Tools and Criminal Trespassing. Officers responded to a call reporting a light that came on in a vacant house that was for sale. Upon investigation, the officers found a broken window and the rear slider door unlocked. While searching the premises, the male was found with burglary tools in his possession. The male was booked into Marysville Jail.

Obstructing/Noise Ordinance Violation, 11/15/14, 10300 blk. of 10th Pl. SE

A 37-year old male was arrested for Obstructing an Officer and Noise Ordinance Violation. Officers were dispatched to a noise complaint – specifically loud music. Upon arrival, officers simply asked the resident to turn down the music. The intoxicated male became very agitated and aggressive when approaching the officer and refused to listen to the officers instructions. The male was placed under arrest for Obstructing an Officer and ticketed for the Noise Ordinance Violation.

Theft of Firearm/Vehicle Prowl, 11/15/14, 9000 blk. of 9th Place SE

A 26-year old female reported that her firearm had been stolen from her unlocked vehicle sometime in the last week. There is no suspect information at this time.
