News Release

The police department responded to 512 incidents in the week of May 17, 2015 through May 23, 2015. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

Assault 4° Domestic Violence (DV), 05-19-15, 10000 block of Lundeen Parkway

A 14 year-old female was arrested and booked into Denney Youth Center for Assault 4, Domestic Violence, after it was reported she had shoved, spit on, and punched her step father with a closed fist after he followed her to a local business and blocked her in an attempt to keep her from running away.

Disorderly Conduct, 05/21/15, 2100 116 Av. NE

Officers were dispatched to a neighborhood disturbance in which the 30 year-old female reported her 27 year-old male neighbor had confronted her about cigarette butts in his yard as she returned from a walk with her dogs and young children. After the female told him she did not smoke, the male became more verbally aggressive, reportedly yelling at her and throwing the cigarette butts at her as he followed her into her yard. His mother was also alleged to have participated in the verbal altercation. The male was also angry and hostile towards the responding officers. Due to several previous similar occurrences at this location, this report was sent to the prosecutor for review for filing of charges.

Burglary/Order Violation, 05/11/15, 2400 blk of Cedar RD

A 23 year-old female was arrested and booked into Snohomish County Jail on Burglary and a Domestic Violation Protection Order Violation after it was found she had entered the residence of the relative that had obtained the protection order. An alert neighbor had observed the woman at the property and immediately called 911 to report it.

Possession of Controlled Substance, Warrants, 05-23-15, 500 SR 9

After officers were dispatched to a local shopping area for a report of a 26 year-old male with possible warrants. They were able to pull up a current photo of the male from their computer and they located him a short time later. The officers confirmed the man had warrants for Theft 3, Forgery, and for violating a No Contact Protection Order. While searching the male, incident to arrest, he was found to have a baggie with white crystal like substances that field tested positive for methamphetamine in his pocket. The male stated, "I don't know anything about it."

Possession of a Controlled Substance charges were added.
