

Incidents-Year By Month






Lake Stevens Total Cases-Year By Month



2013 Cases per Incident




Total Incidents Breakdown




RESPONSE TIMES

Entry to Arrival Response




Entry to Arrival response times depicts the time from when the dispatcher first answered the call to when the officers arrive on scene. Dispatch to arrival is the time from when the officer is dispatched to when the officers arrives. The different call types are what make up the different priorities (E-4). “E” is emergency calls that requires the officer to respond as quickly as possible and are coded down from there. An “E” call would include an assault with a weapon or a robbery for example.

Dispatch to Arrival Response





3rd Quarter Traffic Stops Resulting in Infractions





Lake Stevens Collisions




Lake Stevens DUI Calls





Theft




Vehicle Thefts

NOTABLE CASES and EVENTS

Robbery-SOLVED

A 32-year old male and a 17-year old male were arrested for robbery with a handgun. Officers were dispatched to a robbery complaint at a local convenience store. Containment was set up while Detectives and a K-9 Unit were asked to assist. The K-9 search was successful and both males were located and placed under arrest. A search warrant was received and performed on the vehicle during which time both the handgun and money were recovered. Both males were booked, one in the Juvenile Detention Center and other in Snohomish County Jail.

Collision

Officers investigated a major collision on Soper Hill. The driver of a Kia was passing vehicles at a high rate of speed in attempts to keep up with a motorcycle. He collided with the rear of another vehicle when he could not slow down in time. The second vehicle was pushed into oncoming traffic and collided with another vehicle.

Death Investigation

A 41 year old female was found deceased after being involved in an earlier domestic violence altercation. The female and her 42-year old boyfriend had a verbal argument involving her use of prescription medications. The argument turned physical and the male was arrested for DV Assault and the female transported to the hospital for treatment. Several hours later when the female was found deceased Detectives were called to the scene in the event there was a link to the altercation. The Medical Examiner later determined cause of death to be an accidental overdose.
