News Release

The police department responded to 510 incidents in the week of November 16, 2014 through November 22, 2014. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

DV Disturbance, 11/16/2014, 10000 blk. of 5th Pl SE

Officers responded to a report of a physical altercation in progress. Upon arrival it was discovered that there was an argument between a 38-year old female and her 37-year old boyfriend. The male had left the scene before officers arrived. The female's adult children reported that the boyfriend swung at their mother. The female denied being injured or afraid and would not disclose where her boyfriend went. This case is closed due to the lack of cooperation of the parties involved.

Burglary/Theft, 11/17/2014, 500 blk. of E. Davis Loop Rd.

A 34-year old female reported that she returned home and found that she left her garage door open. Upon investigation, it was found that several items were taken. This case is under investigation pending further information and evidence that may identify any possible suspect(s).

Assault 4 Domestic Violence (DV), 11/19/2014, 12000 blk. of 16th Street NE

A 54-year old female was arrested for Assault 4 DV. Officers responded to a report that the female was being physical with her 64-year old spouse. When the officer arrived, the female was screaming and yelling. Upon investigation, it was found that the argument started over finances. The female slapped her husband and tore his jacket when he tried to walk away. The female was booked into Marysville Jail.

Collision, 11/20/2014, 700 blk. of 91st Ave NE

A 74-year old female and a 34-year old male were involved in a collision at the above address. The female driver of unit 1 was in the left turn lane while the male was in the right turn lane. The female attempted to make a right turn from the left turn lane. She struck the front left corner of the male's vehicle. There were no injuries. The scene was cleared without incident.

Theft/Vehicle Prowl, 11/20/2014, 8400 blk. of 4th Street NE

A 23-year old female reported that her vehicle was broken into and several items were taken. The vehicle prowl was discovered early in the morning. The female discovered that the contents of her glove box and console were gone through. There is no suspect information at this time.
