CALL TO ORDER: 6:30 p.m.

Excused Absence: Moved by Commissioner Hinchcliffe, seconded by Commissioner Tietze, to excuse Commissioners Cruickshank and Hunt from the meeting. Motion carried (6-0-0-1).

Approval of Minutes: It was moved by Commissioner Hinchcliffe, seconded by Commissioner Tietze, to approve the minutes of the April 8, 2015 meeting. Motion carried (6-0-0-1).

Movie in the Park: Lisa Johansen from Bourne Orthodontics reported that Dr. Bourne has tentatively selected the movie "Home" for the Movie in the Park presentation.

Music on the Lake: Commissioner Tietze reported there are many sponsors this year, including Ace Hardware, Windermere Real Estate, Gyro heroes, Farmers Insurance, G. Lindsey and KRKO.

Roundabout Art: Commissioner Forbis reported on her recent meeting with City Administrator Jan Berg. Commissioner Hunt said she has notified the various artists who have submitted proposals of the decision and that it is pending City Council approval.

Art Rotation: Commissioner Hinchcliffe provided an update on the art rotation at City Hall.

Scholarship: Commissioner Hinchcliffe said the Lake Stevens High School counselors estimate there will be ten to twelve applications for the scholarship; awards night is May 27.

Aquafest: This year's theme is "Lights, Camera, Aquafest". Arts Commission-sponsored activities at Aquafest were discussed including Chalk-It-Up, balloons and painting; there was agreement that Chalk-It-Up will be held on July 26, 2015 from 1:00-3:00 p.m., with registration beginning at 12:00 p.m.
