News Release

The police department responded to 465 incidents in the week of March 29, 2015 through April 04, 2015. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

POSSESSION OF HEROIN, 03/30/15, 1100 blk of 85 DR NE

Officers were dispatched to suspicious vehicle, upon contacting that vehicle it appeared that the male was unconscious. The officer knocked on the window and opened the door to check on the male. The male was awakened and proceeded to discuss his drug habits with the officer. The 30 year-old male was arrested for possession of Heroin. The male was booked into Snohomish County Jail.

ASSAULT 4th DEGREE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE (DV)/THEFT/MALICIOUS MISCHIEF, 04/01/2015, 11000 blk of 20th St NE

A 29 year old male was cited for Assault 4 DV, Theft and Malicious Mischief. Officers were dispatched to a priority assault. Upon arriving they spoke with the 16 year-old female victim who stated that the male shut the door on her and stole some of her personal items. The officers observed the damage to the door and the victim's injuries which were consistent with her story. The male fled the scene prior to police arrival. A search of the area and an address were they believed he might be was performed with no results. Charging was sent to Marysville Courts.

BURGLARY/THEFT, 04/03/15, 300 blk of 91 Ave NE

An employee reported that the business was broken into and money was missing. Officers determined how the suspect enter the facility, but do not have any leads in the investigations at this time. Case was closed, pending further suspect information.

STOLEN VEHICLE RECOVERY, 04/03/2015, 700 blk of SR 9 NE

A Lake Stevens Officer located a vehicle which was reported stolen from a Snohomish County Sheriff's jurisdiction. The vehicle was unoccupied and the registered owner was notified. The scene was cleared without incident.

DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE (DUI), 04/04/2015, 500 blk of SR 9 NE

A 19 year-old male was arrested for DUI. Officers were dispatched to a male sleeping in his running vehicle in the drive-thru line. The male appeared unconscious with his foot on the brake pedal. The officer woke the male up and secured his vehicle. The male was processed for DUI and his vehicle was impounded. The male will have charges forwarded to the Marysville Court.

THEFT, 04/04/2015, 300 blk of 91 Ave NE

An officer contacted a male after a report that the male had just stolen a pair of shoes. The suspect admitted that he switched his old shoes for the new ones and walked out of the store. The
