The police department responded to 454 incidents in the week of May 03, 2015 through May 09, 2015. The following is a brief summary of some of the more notable contacts:

**Court Order Violation Domestic Violence (DV), 05/04/15, 8600 blk of 14 PL SE**

An officer responded after a 47-year-old male reported his son had been text-messaging him which is a violation of a court order. A review of the order's conditions supported the information provided. The 29 year-old male was arrested for violating an active DV Protection order. A court summons was issued and the scene and was cleared without further incident.

**Possession of Stolen Vehicle/Eluding/Warrants, 05/05/15, 2000 blk of 79<sup>th</sup> Ave SE**

A Lake Stevens Detective located an occupied stolen vehicle with one driver and two passengers. The vehicle stopped; one passenger and the driver got out of the vehicle. The 33 year-old male passenger jumped back into the vehicle and speed off. The detective stayed with the previous driver of the vehicle and an assisting officer attempted to stop the fleeing vehicle, but terminated the pursuit a short time later. The vehicle was located by Snohomish County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) when a witness reported the male drove the vehicle into his yard. A 33 year-old male was arrested for Possession of a Stolen Vehicle and Eluding. The male suspect was booked into Snohomish County Jail.

**Possession of Marijuana, 05/05/15, 2200 blk of 117<sup>th</sup> Ave NE**

An officer performed a traffic stop when he discover the smell of marijuana eliminating from the vehicle. The driver identified the passenger as the one with the marijuana. The passenger handed over the marijuana. The officer contacted the parent of the involved juveniles. A 16 year-old male was arrested for Possession of Marijuana. The driver was cited for speeding and the passenger had charges referred to Snohomish County Juvenile Court.

**Assault 2/Collision, 05/09/15, 1900 blk of SR 204**

An officer responded to a collision which began with a road rage incident. One driver reported the other stopped without warning causing the vehicles to collide. He stated both vehicles were in the process of pulling over when he saw a flash and thought it was a firearm. Fearful for his safety he did not pull over. The other driver reported he pulled to the side of the road after his vehicle was hit from behind. The other vehicle just continued to drive. The officer determined both vehicle were driving reckless. A 44 year-old male was arrested for Assault 2 after it was reported that he rammed another vehicle 2-3 times. The officer referred charged for the 44 year-old male to Snohomish County Superior Court.
