Farmer's Market: (Tina Kitburi, Chair)

All bands have been confirmed except for the Navy band. Sponsorship queries are being made. No sponsorship commitments by any business yet.

To raise further funds, Commissioner Kitburi moved that we rent the Music on the Lake canopy to the Iron Man organization for \$250.00, with a damage clause written into the contract. The rental fee would be deposited into the City Arts Commission fund. Commissioner Noel seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Flyers and application forms are ready for printing. 30 flyers and 60 entry forms will be printed.
