

## Lake Stevens Total Incidents-Year By Month






## Lake Stevens Total Cases-Year By Month



## 2013 Cases per Incident




## Lake Stevens Total Incidents Breakdown




# RESPONSE TIMES

## Lake Stevens Entry To Arrival Response




Entry to Arrival response times depicts the time from when the dispatcher first answered the call to when the officers arrive on scene. Dispatch to arrival is the time from when the officer is dispatched to when the officers arrives. The different call types are what make up the different priorities (E-4). "E" is emergency calls that requires the officer to respond as quickly as possible and are coded down from there. An "E" call would include an assault with a weapon or a robbery for example.



## Lake Stevens Traffic Stops Resulting in Infractions





## Lake Stevens DUI Calls




## Lake Stevens Collisions







# NOTABLE CASES

## ***Homicide/Drive by Shooting—SOLVED***

On Saturday, June 1st, 2013 around 11:15 pm, Molly Conley, 15, was shot and killed as she was walking with some friends along the 10600 blk. of S. Lake Stevens Road, in Lake Stevens. Molly was celebrating her 15th birthday. The bullet that struck Molly came from a dark colored vehicle that drove past them. Lake Stevens Detectives and Snohomish County Major Crimes partnered together and on Jul 1st made an arrest. The suspect is in jail awaiting trial.

## ***Homicide—SOLVED***

On Monday, June 17 around 9 a.m. Phillipa S. Evans-Lopez, 20, was found stabbed to death inside her home. Officers entered the home and found the body and then waited for a search warrant. Once again, Lake Stevens Detectives and Snohomish County Major Crimes partnered together and on July 2nd made an arrest. The suspect is in jail awaiting trial.

## ***Home Invasion Robbery—SOLVED UPDATE***

Two adult males broke into a motor home located near the 400 block of Davies Road in the City of Lake Stevens. The victims, two adult males who lived in the motor home, reported the incident to 911 stating they had been attacked and “beat” by the intruders.

All three suspects were interviewed and booked into the Snohomish County Jail for Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> degree and Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree.

**\*\*3 suspects each sentenced to 3-6 years a piece in prison\*\***

## ***Quizno's Robbery-SOLVED UPDATE***

An unknown male robbed the Lake Stevens Quizno's restaurant at knife point. The suspect appeared to be alone and fled on foot. During the course of the investigation, information was obtained that led to an arrest. The suspect is currently in jail.

**\*\*Suspect sentenced to 16 months in prison\*\***

## ***2012 Notable Case Update***

- The suspect who was arrested in both the Key Bank and Rite Aid Robberies was sentenced to 5 years in prison
- A suspect charged with Child Sexual Assault was sentenced to 5 years in prison

## ***2011 Notable Case Update***

- In 2011 LSPD came upon the largest drug seizure in Snohomish County history by simply knocking on a door for a warrant arrest. This case caught the attention of the FBI and became a vital piece in their case and assisted in the Federal Indictment of 34 individuals. In May several Lake Stevens Police Employees testified in Federal Court. All 34 suspects were convicted and are in jail; only 5 are fugitives from justice.
