Park Description: The Centennial Trail is a paved trail between Arlington and Snohomish for walking, bicycling, hiking, and horseback riding, accessible to persons of all physical abilities. The Centennial Trail skirts the eastern city limits; however, 1.3 miles of the trail is within the city limits. There trail has several formal and informal trailheads within or adjacent to the City.
