Circulation & Regional System Improvement

PROJECT BENEFITS

Economic Development - Accommodates new jobs and commercial expansion in the area, including further build-out and improvements that the operators of Frontier Village will only construct with an upgraded SR 9/SR 204.

Improved Safety - Currently more than 1/3rd of the SR 9 accidents occur at this intersection. Project reduces accidents and severity of injuries.

Circulation Improvement - Will improve movement and capacity to better accommodate peak-hour traffic and reduce clogging and lineups of vehicles/freight.

Multi-modal - Will accommodate multi-modal trips, improvements, and connections.

Supported by Community – Support has been given by the business community, local development, local freight, Community Transit, Fire District, and the general public.

Plan Support – Project has been identified as a priority in the WSDOT SR 9 Route Development Plan, SR 9/SR 204 WSDOT Study Plan, **and** Snohomish County Multimodal Transportation 30-year Plan.

Project Cost - \$58 million

Schedule – Preliminary design is complete and ready to go to final design.
