

# Willard Wyatt County Park



**Park Description:** Wyatt Park is a three-acre regional park, originally known as Davies Beach, that overlooks the beautiful waters of Lake Stevens and provides views of the snow-capped Cascade Mountains. Facilities include a public boat launch, a boat dock, fishing pier, swimming area, restrooms, picnic tables, and public parking.
