CURRENT CITY PROJECTS

Decant Facility



A new decant facility is under construction; a joint effort with the Sewer District supporting 50% of the cost. It is designed to receive, process and dispose of stormwater and sewer contaminates. The foundation has been poured and a new steel building on its way.

North Cove Park—Phase II



Phase I was the completion of The Mill on Lake Stevens, the multi-use building located in at North Cove Park, that is home to the City Council Chambers and the Lake Stevens Farmers' Market. Phase II has begun, the construction of an inclusive playground, an observational deck and additional parking.

Frontier Heights Park



The City's newest park, near the Highway 204/Highway 9 intersection, is near completion. The playground equipment, picnic tables, and basketball hoops have been installed.

Police Department



The Lake Stevens Police Department is moving to a new location where work continues on the Police Department Evidence/Training building.

IN THE WORKS

The Civic Center on Chapel Hill

The City, Sno-Isle Libraries, and Lake Stevens Sewer District are exploring the potential for a private-public partnership to build a joint civic campus. There is a new civic center website www.lakestevenswa.gov/civiccenter that is updated with current information and project updates.

SE Interlocal Annexation



The city is currently pursuing an interlocal agreement with Snohomish County to annex approximately 1,000 properties within its Southeast Urban Growth Area (UGA). On December 9, the City will be hosting a second public meeting to provide an update on the proposed annexation.

Representatives from Snohomish County and the Lake Stevens Sewer District will also be in attendance. The meeting will start at 6:30 pm and held via the Zoom online platform. Visit the city's website www.lakestevenswa.gov/491/Annexation for current information and link for the Zoom meeting.
