CURRENT CITY PROJECTS

North Cove Park—Phase II and III

The playground and picnic shelter are moving closer and closer to completion. Phase III is currently in development, which includes the construction of Mill Spur, requiring the relocation of the Lake Stevens Historical Museum, the Grimm House and the Lake Stevens Library.



The museum's contents are now in their temporary residence at the 'old fire station' until the new facility is built.

The library is providing limited services out of Lundein Park during renovations to their temporary building at 2211 Grade Road. Services at Lundein Park are Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Decant Facility

The City celebrated the opening of the new decant facility the last week of April. The facility protects the environment by processing and disposing of pollutants from sewers, stormwater drains, and other utility projects. It also saves utility ratepayers money and reduces the City's overall carbon footprint.

Planning and Community Development

The City has received 341 building permit submittals to date since January 1, 2021. We approved and issued the tenant improvement and sign permit for Benjamin Moore Landon Paint store in Frontier Village. This store occupies the last available space and brings it to 100% occupancy for Frontier Village.



The Park 20 Apartments had the final inspection for Building 3 and another 20 units. They are also prepping and paving additional parking areas behind Buildings 3 and 5.
