CURRENT CITY PROJECTS

South Lake Stevens Road Closure

As part of a broader effort to improve safety and manage traffic congestion, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is building a roundabout at the intersection of SR 9 and South Lake Stevens Road in Lake Stevens.



South Lake Stevens Road has closed to support the roundabout project. Detour signs are in place to guide traffic around the closure. The City of Lake Stevens remains committed to keeping the community informed of traffic pattern changes, progress, and updates to this project; the City's website post will be maintained as information becomes available from WSDOT.

Smart Communities Award

The Governor's Office announced its winners for its Smart Communities Awards in October of last year, and Lake Stevens is on the list. The city, one of just 11 recipients, was honored for the Downtown Subarea Plan to create a city center and gathering place for residents and visitors.

At the November 23, 2021 Council meeting, the GSCA Crystal award was presented to the community. Recently, a film crew visited North Cove Park and The Mill to interview Mayor Gailey, former Mayor Spencer and Russ Wright, Community Development Director, to discuss the project's ongoing progress. City Council Special Meeting/Retreat

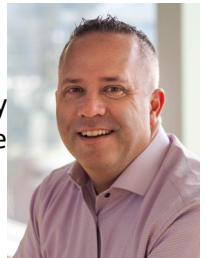
