Highway 9 Improvements For Traffic Flow

The Washington State Department of Transportation is improving the intersections of State Highways 9 and 204. WSDOT is planning three extended closures during construction this summer. Closing Highway 9 will impact traffic and cause delays, and we ask for your patience.
