The City is pursuing accreditation from the nationally-recognized American Public Works Association (APWA). The process will improve efficiency, safety, and service levels of the Public Works Department.

The APWA Accreditation process establishes and reinforces best management practices in the public works industry. Taxpayers can expect more efficient delivery of services and streamlined budget requests because projects are developed around industry standards.

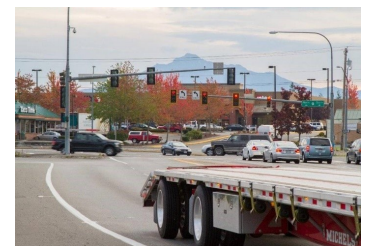

Visit the 2022 Lake Stevens Farmers Market at North Cove Park, Wednesdays 3 - 7 pm through August 31.

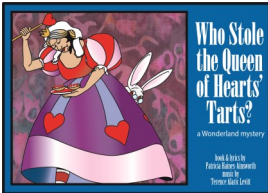

Theater in the Park

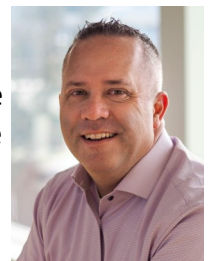
