The first phase of the Bayview Trail construction started July 29, 2024, with an estimated end day in November 2024. The project will include the construction of the parking lot, benches, and dog park at West Lake Park.

91st Ave SE Sidewalk Phase 1	2024 Pavement Preservation
<p>Construction has started on the sidewalk along the east side of 91st Avenue SE between 8th Street SE and Market Place. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of September 2024.</p> <p>The 91st Avenue SE Sidewalk project will complete a continuous pedestrian and bicycle route on the east side of 91st Avenue SE, between 8th Street SE and Market Place.</p> <p>The new route will provide a pedestrian and bicycle link between nearby neighborhoods, three schools, and the commercial area on Market Place. The project will comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) guidelines. This project is supported by the Transportation Benefit Program.</p> <p>For more information and to sign up for updates: https://lakestevenswa.civilspace.io/en/projects/91st-avenue-se-sidewalk-phase-1</p>	<p>The City will be performing a roadway asphalt grind and overlay with associated ADA curb ramp upgrades, sidewalk improvements, and crosswalk updates as required, based on the impacted areas. The project also includes some full-depth spot repairs, utility adjustments, and replacing existing roadway markings. The project locations are:</p> <p>Site 1: 113th Ave NE from SR92 to 32nd St NE Site 2: 20th St NE from Ashley Pointe to 116th Ave NE Site 3: 4th St NE from SR9 to 99th Ave NE Site 4: Vernon Rd from the bridge (1706 Vernon Rd) to Lundeen Parkway roundabout Site 5: Vernon Rd from Lundeen Parkway to 91st Ave NE Site 6: 22nd Place NE from 130th Dr NE to Cul-de-sac</p> <p>For more information and to sign up for updates: https://lakestevenswa.civilspace.io/en/projects/2024-pavement-preservation</p>
