Frontier Heights

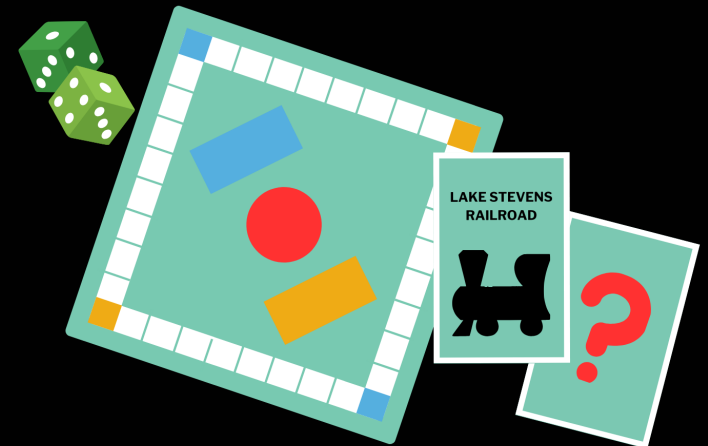
- Construction on Phase II of the Frontier Heights development will begin this year.

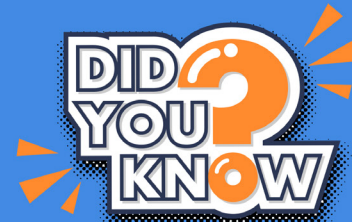
