


Bayview Trail Groundbreaking Ceremony

The City held a ribbon cutting ceremony for the Bayview Trail - Phase 0, at West Lake Park, on January 6, 2025. This phase, from 20th Street SE to 12th Street SE, is open, with construction planned to extend the trail to 8th Street SE this year. Lake Stevens will construct the trail north to the city limits at Soper Hill Road, and the City of Marysville will extend the existing Bayview Trail south from SR 528 to Soper Hill Road. When complete, walkers and cyclists will enjoy a paved trail from Lake Stevens through Marysville, via the Bayview Trail, connecting directly to the regional Centennial Trail. This project is the first step in connecting our community to the City of Marysville with a non-motorized trail. Coming soon....a dog park is opening this spring at West Lake Park!
