North Cove


- Path around the art tower was installed and vegetation will be planted in April.
- Top dressing on the great lawn at the end of April and a two week closure for lawn renovation and reseeding.





Items Accepted

Bagged trash, non-hazardous waste, tires, bulk metal, furniture and yard debris.

- Items must be bundled, boxed or bagged.
- Branches, limbs and yard waste must be wrapped or bundled in lengths of no more than three feet.
- Large tree rounds or entire trees are not accepted.
- Tires are accepted but must be dismounted.
- **There is no limit to the number of bundles; however, each citizen is responsible for their own unloading of items brought to the event.**

Items Not Accepted

- Refrigerators and freezers
- Electronics (microwaves, TVs, monitors, speakers, etc.)
- Paints, solvents, pesticides, gasoline or cleaning materials
- Rocks, concrete or construction debris
- Sod, large trees or rounds
- Non-bagged or bundled trash


