Lake Stevens Presents at APWA Conference

August 17-20, 2025

The city had the honor of representing Lake Stevens at the American Public Works Association's Public Works Expo conference in Chicago. The city was asked to present two workshop sessions and to be a part of a panel discussion.

Since successfully completing the American Public Works Association (APWA) accreditation process, the city was asked to share our three-year long journey, lessons learned along the way, and tips on how to bring focus and long-term success to work projects. The presentation, "Doing More With Less by Improving Processes and Culture" session was presented by our Mayor, Human Resources Director, Public Works Director, and Public Works Analyst.

The second presentation session was "Demolishing Waste While Building with Legos" presented by our Mayor, Human Resources Director, and Public Works Analyst. This presentation focused on Lean Six Sigma training and how to problem solve, identify waste, and continuously improving processes.

Our City Administrator was asked to sit on the "What City and County Managers Want Public Works Directors to Know" panel discussion to bring awareness to the importance of strong working relationships and departmental collaboration to ensure communities thrive.

What an honor to showcase the hard work and dedication of our city at a national level. Lake Stevens joined the elite group of 214 other cities across the country who have also received the APWA accreditation. Since receiving an impressive 99.7% full compliance rating, the city has improved customer service, efficiency, and overall safety. Working three years towards the accreditation has created a work culture of accountability and efficiency as well as a bond rating upgrade from Aa2 to Aa1 by Moody's.

Have you heard the news about the Lake Stevens Boat Launches?

Annual Passes are available for purchase at City Hall and at the kiosk for \$75/year, \$60/year for Lake Stevens residents. The City of Lake Stevens annual pass is accepted at both launches. North Cove Beach and Davies Beach boat launches are a \$10/day fee and offer a \$5/per three-hour short-term parking option.

Parking is enforced at North Cove and Davies Beach boat launches. \$100 citations will be issued for parking violations. Per LSMC 7.12.090: Failure to display valid permit or receipt for paying day use fees and cars parked in designated boat trailer stalls. Citations are issued by the Lake Stevens Police Department and directed to the Marysville Court for processing. Citations will be issued for non-payment of fees.

Snohomish County Parks boat launch access passes will no longer be accepted at Davies Beach, after December 31, 2025.

The Discover Pass will no longer be accepted at the North Cove boat launch after November 30, 2025.

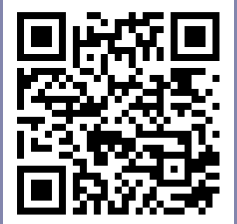
Main Street Improvement Project
