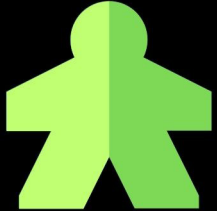

Bayview Trail Phase .5	Construction to begin Fall 2025.
Bayview Trail Phase I	Design and engineering (currently at 30%) to proceed beginning Fall/Winter 2025.
Cedarwood Property Development	Design and engineering Fall/Winter 2025.
Davies Beach Pier Restoration	Structural engineering inspection and analysis.
Eagle Ridge Park Phase II	Project on hold. Design and Engineering to resume Fall/Winter 2025.
Frontier Heights Park Phase II	Construction to begin Fall 2025.
North Cove Low Float Dock Phase II	Dock extension to be installed in August/September 2025.
North Cove Motorized Dock Replacement (Marina)	Design and engineering Fall/Winter 2025.
