



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES WITH CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

The City of Lake Stevens is seeking to fill vacancies on:

SALARY COMMISSION: 1 vacancy with a mid-term ending December 31, 2024.

The Salary Commission establishes salaries of elected officials on realistic standards so that elected officials are paid in accordance with their duties and so that citizens of the highest quality are attracted to public service. The Salary Commission meets annually between January 1 and November 1 to study and establish the salaries of elected officials.

LIBRARY BOARD: 1 mid-term vacancy with a term ending December 31, 2024.

The Library Board works with Sno-Isle Regional Library System in providing services to the Lake Stevens citizenry. The Library Board meets quarterly in January, April, July and October on the third Thursday of at 4:30 p.m.

VETERANS COMMISSION: 2 vacancies with terms ending December 31, 2024.

The Veterans Commission represents the U.S. military veteran constituency in the Lake Stevens community and works to provide support and opportunities to veterans and their families within the community. The Veterans Commission meets on the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

PLANNING COMMISSION: 1 vacancy with a term ending December 31, 2024.

The Planning Commission is the principal planning advisory body to the City Council for matters relating to land use, the Growth Management Act, comprehensive planning and zoning issues. The Planning Commission meets the first Wednesday of every month at 6:00 p.m.

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION: 1 vacancy with a term ending December 31, 2027.

The Civil Service Commission executes the City of Lake Stevens Civil Service Rules and Regulations in connection with the selection, appointment and employment of police officers and department staff. The Civil Service Commission meets every other month, or as needed.

Members of the City's boards and commissions serve without compensation and must be city residents or reside within the urban growth area.
