The Veterans Commission represents the U.S. military veteran constituency in the Lake Stevens community and works to provide support and opportunities to veterans and their families within the community. The Veterans Commission meets on the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

LIBRARY BOARD: 2 vacancies ending December 31, 2023 and December 31, 2024.

The Library Board works with Sno-Isle Regional Library System in providing services to the Lake Stevens citizenry. The Library Board meets quarterly in January, April, July and October on the third Thursday of at 4:30 p.m.
