**Permits Required:** Final plat in addition to already approved permits.

**Review Process:** A final plat is a Type II decision which is an administrative decision by the city's Community Development Director

**SEPA Environmental Review:**

The project is exempt from SEPA per WAC 197-11-800(6) – Land use decisions.
