SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Project Name (No.): Stavig Bulkhead/Rockery Replacement (LUA2025-0060)

Proponent: City of Lake Stevens

Description of Proposal: The applicant is proposing to complete work to replace a failed concrete bulkhead with two rockery walls near the shoreline of Lake Stevens. The applicant has applied for a retroactive permit after a Stop Work Order was initiated (COD2024-0166). According to the geotechnical report, two rockery walls are necessary to replace the previous concrete bulkhead and protect the existing home. The applicant is proposing to revegetate the shoreline area as mitigation for the additional rockery wall and the vegetation lost during the bulkhead site work. The applicant is also proposing to replace two sets of existing concrete steps landward of the Ordinary High-Water Mark. A SEPA determination is triggered pursuant to WAC 197-11-180 as the project will be conducted on lands covered by water pursuant to WAC 197-11-800 (1)(i). The lot is developed with a single-family residence located within the Waterfront Residential (WR) zoning district. Pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 14.88 of Lake Stevens Municipal Code (LSMC) and Chapter 7 of the LSSMP, the applicant has applied for a shoreline exemption. A retroactive building permit will be required.
