



CITY OF LAKE STEVENS VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES – ARTS COMMISSION

The City of Lake Stevens is seeking community members living in the City limits or the Lake Stevens Urban Growth Boundary interested in serving on the Arts Commission. The Arts Commission primarily focuses on visual, performing, literary and historic cultural categories of the City as well as other cultural categories as defined by the Washington State Arts Commission. The Arts Commission is responsible for presenting Music By the Lake and Theater in the Park each year, as well as other seasonal community arts and cultural events.

The current openings are to fill two vacant positions for terms expiring December 31, 2020 and December 31, 2022. The Arts Commission holds a regular evening meeting at 6:30 p.m. on the second Wednesday of the month and an optional second meeting on the fourth Wednesday of the month. Additionally, subcommittees are formed and meet regularly to plan and execute Arts Commission-sponsored events and activities.
