PLANNING COMMISSION

The City of Lake Stevens is seeking two community members living in the City limits or the Lake Stevens Urban Growth Area interested in serving on the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission is the principal planning advisory body to the City Council for matters relating to land use, the Growth Management Act, comprehensive planning and zoning issues. The current openings are to fill two vacant positions, one with a term expiring December 31, 2023 and the second position with a term expiring on December 31, 2020. The Planning Commission holds regular evening meetings (7:00 p.m.) on the first Wednesday of the month. Occasionally a Planning Commission meeting is held on the third Wednesday of the month.
