



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES WITH CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

The City of Lake Stevens is seeking to fill vacancies on:

SALARY COMMISSION: 1 vacancy with a term ending December 31, 2023.

The Salary Commission establishes salaries of elected officials on realistic standards so that elected officials are paid in accordance with their duties and so that citizens of the highest quality are attracted to public service. The Salary Commission meets annually between January 1 and November 1 to study and establish the salaries of elected officials. Eligibility to hold a Salary Commission position is set forth in Lake Stevens Municipal Code Section 2.51.020(b) which requires that members must be a U.S. citizen, and a resident of the City of Lake Stevens for at least one-year preceding appointment.

LIBRARY BOARD: 3 vacancies with terms ending December 31, 2023.

The Library Board works with Sno-Isle Regional Library System in providing services to the Lake Stevens citizenry. The Library Board meets quarterly in January, April, July and October on the third Thursday of at 4:30 p.m.

VETERANS COMMISSION: 1 (or potentially 2) vacancies for terms ending December 31, 2023.

The Veterans Commission represents the U.S. military veteran constituency in the Lake Stevens community and works to provide support and opportunities to veterans and their families within the community. The Veterans Commission meets on the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

PARK BOARD: One vacancy ending December 31, 2021.

The Park Board holds regular meetings at 6:00 p.m. on the second Monday of each month. The Park Board is the principal planning advisory body for all matters relating to parks and the provision of recreation services.

Members of the City's boards and commissions serve without compensation and must be city residents or reside within the urban growth area.
